I am directed by the Governor General to acknowledge the receipt of several requisitions from the Indians under your superintendence for money to be devoted to the assistance of the distressed Scotch + Irish, and I am to request that you will convey to each of the Tribes the expression of the Governor General's great satisfaction that Indians in Canada should thus have come forward to the aid of their suffering white brethren.
